The minutes of the July 17, 2017 meeting were approved.

Rector's Report

- July attendance: Sunday (5 weekends, includes Saturday)-97;
 Wednesdays-10; Brookdale-6. On August 2, Fr. Joe had Eucharist at Oakmont and will do so the first Wednesday afternoon of each month.
- Fr. Joe is meeting every Sunday with individuals who will be confirmed or received on Sunday, September 10 during the 10:30 a.m. Eucharist. There will be a covered dish in their honor in the Parish Hall after10:30 Eucharist. Michael Webb and Sharon Kyser will assist with set up.
- The Rev. Kathy Dunagan is coordinating music for the Rhythm and Roots weekend on Sunday, September 17 at the 10:30 a.m. Eucharist.
- Fr. Joe will be out of the parish the later part of this week.
- The James Street parking lot has been completed. Superior Paving will repair the lot across the street when the weather permits.
- The bell tower doors have been repaired and painted. New door securing bolts are being made by a blacksmith for these doors.
- The nursery renovation is complete and is now open on the second floor across from the conference room.
- Heather Eisenhart and Chris Yoder met with K. D. Forsha and have made improvements to the sound system in the church.
