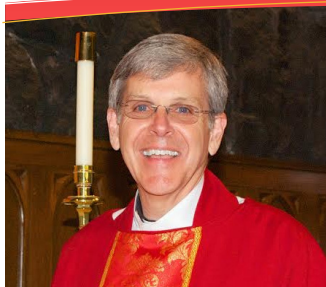

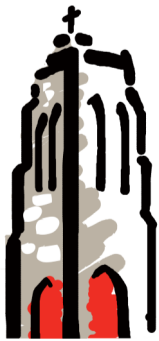
The meeting was adjourned by the rector.
