#### From the Rector

I am thinking about my grandmother lately more than usual. I've been asked to speak at the Bristol Tennessee/Virginia Rotary Club in a few weeks about Rotary International's effort to eliminate polio once and for all. We are very close but there are still too many children who will go through life with the effects of this completely preventable disease. My grandmother was born in 1904 and contracted what was then known as infantile paralysis. Poliomyelitis is a devastating viral disease that often leaves its victims with disfiguring paralysis. In my grandmother's case, one leg was paralyzed. Growing up I saw her wheelchairs and crutches. I learned early to hold her wheelchair in a certain spot so she could transfer into and out of the car. That was about the only time I remember having to help her.

In the living room of her house was a huge upright piano. She would take one of several hymnals that were always on the piano and turn to whatever hymn she wanted to play. I think that was more for dramatic effect than necessity. She had long since learned them by heart. I learned those gospel songs from her heart to mine.

Rhythm and Roots is an opportunity to reflect on music which is not only entertaining but formative. This Sunday Emmanuel will be surrounded by a great festival honoring the community's musical heritage. We will welcome our special guests *Empty Bottle String Band* to the ten-thirty Eucharist. Our choir will vest for the first time since their summer hiatus. It is a great time to live in Bristol and a wonderful day in the life of Emmanuel as we offer the sounds of voices and instruments, returning to God the gift of music.
