From the Rector

Go into all the world and proclaim the good news to the whole creation. I admit that I have never thought much about that verse near the end of Mark's gospel. Mark doesn't say that we should proclaim the good news of Christ to all people or nations but to all *creation*. St. Francis took those words literally. He is said to have preached the good news to people, for sure. That isn't surprising. But he also preached to animals telling them they were beloved of God. That is a bit surprising but sweet. It is more than surprising that he also preached to rocks!

Occasionally someone will ask me if our pets go to heaven. The Bible doesn't say one way or the other but St. Francis gives us a wonderful perspective on this. He took as his mission to proclaim the good news to all creatures. He called all God's creatures his brothers and sisters, hence *Brother Son and Sister Moon*. He is said to have entered into a contract with a wolf who had been terrorizing the people of a nearby town.

I'm glad for the witness of Francis to respect and give thanks for all God's creatures, not just pets and not only the animate.
