From the Rector

Some of you saw the picture on my Facebook timeline of the old post office under construction. In the picture, there are three men worming on the foundation of the new building while nine watched. Some things don't change! On the other hand, much has changed. The post office was built and served the community for decades before the new consolidated post office was built. There is a large house on the corner where the labyrinth is now and another very large house where Emmanuel's parish hall is. In the corner of the photograph you can see the eastern façade of the original church building.

As I looked at the picture of our neighborhood in 1932 I wondered what life was like then. I also wondered what our neighborhood will be like in eighty years from now. Will Emmanuel still stand as a witness to the message that God is with us in this century as it did in the past? It will if we embrace the living tradition of our faith. Religious tradition lives when our hearts and minds are opened by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. On Wednesday evenings during Lent, we will consider what it means to be part of a *living tradition* as we focus on preparation for baptism and the renewal of the baptismal covenant at the Easter Vigil.

We know the importance of financial endowments to preserve great buildings. Think of our observance of a holy Lent as investing in a spiritual endowment.
