From the Rector

Is liturgy missional? Can we be missional inside our building? We believe we can and are trusting the Holy Spirit to inspire our ongoing mission.

Music is integral to the heritage of Bristol and the Appalachian towns and homesteads that surround us. In the summer of 1927 a producer from the Victor Talking Machine Company set up a temporary studio in Bristol and invited musicians from the area to record their offerings. Among the artists he recorded were Jimmie Rodgers and the Carter Family. That event continues to be celebrated with the annual Bristol Rhythm and Roots Reunion and it gave Bristol bragging rights as the birthplace of country music. Sixty thousand people came to downtown Bristol last year for the festival.

Emmanuel Church sits on the hill above the festival. More than just enjoying some of the best parking places in town during the festival, we wanted to use our imaginations to come up with creative ways to take advantage of our location for the sake of God's mission. Our first thoughts included putting a spotlight on the bell tower or hanging a huge banner on the building advertising our website. Both are probably good ideas but neither felt creative or particularly spiritual.

The Birthplace of Country Music Museum recently produced an album entitled *Orthophonic Joy* featuring the 1927 Bristol Sessions music and commentary. The name comes from an early record player marketed as the Victor Orthophonic Victrola. That name reminded how often my first liturgy professor told us that *orthodoxy* literally means authentic praise. We wondered what would happen if we brought joyful *orthophonic* music into Emmanuel's orthodox liturgy? So we invited some outstanding musicians including Ron Short and Randy Stanley to help us with our principal Sunday Eucharist during Rhythm and Roots weekend.

Tradition has ascribed to St. Augustine the saying that one who sings prays twice. We are asking our neighbors to teach us to sing the songs of Zion with instruments that for generations have accompanied life in the mountains that surround us. Missional liturgy is aware of, present to, and a companion of the community.
