From the Rector

There's a Facebook posting that says life can be summed up in one sentence: *That didn't go as planned!* Indeed. I think it was Eisenhower who said, "Planning is everything. Plans are nothing." I think that means that we need to have a plan with the expectation that things change and plans must be revisited.

The Harald-Courier sometimes has quotes from famous people imbedded among the articles and editorials. One of them, attributed to Henry Ford, was, "Coming together is a beginning; keeping together is progress; working together is success."

Too often we start with a plan when we should start with people. Jim Collins, the business writer, called it getting *the right people on the bus*. He observed some successful companies were begun not with a business plan but with a small group of people who liked each other and worked well together.

I think these thoughts have great implications for the Church. We want to start with ministry. We want to change the world and we want to do it now. We have a vision and a plan. That is all admirable but, if it is a spiritual ministry, we should start with discipleship. Remember the model Jesus gave us by his own example. After his baptism, Jesus spent time in prayer. Then he called disciples (the word means *students*). From the disciples he sent out apostles to baptize new disciples. That formula changed the world forever!
