The King Institute for Faith and Culture in partnership with the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum is bringing Holocaust survivor Theodora Klayman to speak at the college chapel at 9:15 a.m. and at Emmanuel at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, February 27.

Ms. Klayman grew up in Ludbreg, Croatia where she lived in constant fear of detection by the Ustasa regime, which collaborated with the Nazis. She is often asked to share her moving story of being hidden, along with her brother, first by an aunt and then, after the aunt was deported, by non-Jewish neighbors.
